Senior Residents who have a passion for research can also opt for the Clinician Scientist (CS) Residency Track on our Programme. CS Residents will undergo a minimum of 18 months of clinical training in addition to one year of protected research time under the supervision of a research mentor.

YOUR CAREER PROSPECTS & DEVELOPMENT

Senior Residents who complete the SingHealth Gastroenterology Medical Subspecialty Senior Residency programme will be capable of independent practice as a competent gastroenterologist. You will be well-prepared to pass the Specialist Accreditation Board's exit examinations that will enable you to practice as an accredited specialist in the field of Gastroenterology in Singapore, and provide Gastroenterology services to the various hospitals in the country.

Selected candidates will have the opportunity for further training in subspecialty fields (e.g. liver transplantation, endoscopic retrograde cholangiopancreatography (ERCP), etc.) both locally and abroad, as part of a fellowship training programme.

Our Clinician Scientist (CS) Residency Track provides research-inclined clinicians with valuable bench-to bedside exposure, providing the substrate for a fulfilling career in leading scientific discovery in the field of Gastroenterology and Hepatology.


