LEADING NEUROLOGY TEACHING AND RESEARCH CENTRE

You will train at the National Neuroscience Institute (NNI) – the largest Neurology teaching, research and healthcare provider in Singapore. With our large pool of clinicians in two campuses — Singapore General Hospital (SGH) and Tan Tock Seng Hospital (TTSH), NNI provides Neurology services to SGH, TTSH, Changi General Hospital (CGH), Khoo Teck Puat Hospital (KTPH) and Sengkang General Hospital (SKH). We also provide tertiary care to regional patients regularly. Our diverse patient population provides ample opportunities for Senior Residents to manage the entire spectrum of neurological disorders.

COMMITTED AND INTERNATIONALLY RECOGNISED FACULTY

Our Faculty members are a diverse group of Clinicians, Scientists and Educators who take pride in helping our Neurology Senior Residents gain the skills required to become master clinicians and critical thinkers. We are well-represented across the subspecialties of Neurology and are actively engaged in the clinical management of patients, teaching medical students and Residents as well as clinical and translational research. Our internationally recognised staff provide mentorship to Senior Residents to help them develop fulfilling and successful careers. The quality relationships and strong camaraderie in our department means that Senior Residents and Faculty work hand-in-hand in patient care, teaching, and research, and enjoy lively interactions, both at work and leisure.

STRUCTURED BUT FLEXIBLE PROGRAMME

We offer a comprehensive, structured, yet flexible programme that provides diverse clinical experiences in order to meet the career goals of each individual. The programme is based on a competency framework with clear milestones. You will be trained to fulfil these seven major physician roles: medical expert, communicator, collaborator, manager, health advocate, scholar, and professional.

OUR CURRICULUM

The Neurology Senior Residency programme is a three-year training programme. Harnessing the strengths of our large number of patients and staff in both the SGH and TTSH campuses, we have a combined Senior Residency programme with two training sites and you will be rotated to both of them during your training. You will have a principal site supervisor who will mentor you throughout your three years and ensure your learning needs are met.

At each training site, Neurology Senior Residents will receive training in both inpatient and outpatient settings.

You will be given opportunities for rotations at inpatient and outpatient clinics, and take on neurodiagnostic laboratory training, Neurology subspecialty and elective postings. You can expect structured teaching through teaching rounds and activities, journal clubs and grand round presentations. You will also be encouraged to participate in research, educational and quality initiatives as part of the holistic training for medical practitioners. To help you achieve your learning milestones and master the necessary competencies, we offer regular assessments, evaluations, feedback and individualised progression plans.

YOUR CAREER PROSPECTS & DEVELOPMENT

Upon completion of Senior Residency training, Residents can either join our institution as a staff member or other local/overseas medical institutes to pursue your niche in clinical, academic or research work. SingHealth offers four career tracks on completion of advanced specialty training – Clinician Practitioner, Clinician Educator, Clinician Researcher and Clinician Administrator. As you grow your specialist career in Neuroscience Academic Clinical Programme (ACP)*, you will find a myriad of opportunities available in the areas of education and research.

**ACP is a cluster-wide framework for all clinical specialties to advance in Academic Medicine with resources and funding support from SingHealth and Duke-NUS. Each ACP is based on a clinical discipline and brings together all specialists in the discipline across various institutions for greater synergies in clinical care, education and research.*
