Paediatrics is truly one area of medicine where you can make a huge impact on the life of not only one individual child, but also on everyone within the child's circle – the parents, grandparents, siblings and friends.

Paediatrics can be tough – physically and emotionally – but the rewards are immense on so many levels. With the SingHealth Residency Paediatrics programme, we will equip you with the expertise and knowledge to be an outstanding paediatrician. We offer access to all the major paediatric medical and surgical subspecialties, in both acute hospital and ambulatory settings. Furthermore, with your own dedicated Continuity Care (CC) clinic, you can follow-up your very own patients longitudinally, from their initial acute

illness during their in-patient stay, through to post-discharge follow-up, including anticipatory guidance and developmental follow-up of the younger ones. You will have a faculty mentor for the duration of your Residency to nurture you and help develop an Individualised Learning Plan [ILP] to maximise your learning and training needs. The Paediatrics Residency Faculty will provide you with excellent supervision and guidance within the various subspecialty rotations and Residency specific matters.

WIDE EXPOSURE AT KK WOMEN'S AND CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL (KKH) – SINGAPORE'S MAIN PAEDIATRIC TEACHING HOSPITAL

The main training site for the SingHealth Paediatric Residency programme is at KKH – Singapore's only dedicated integrated hospital for women and children. KKH is an 827-bed Joint Commission International (JCI)-accredited hospital with a 365-bed dedicated children's Facility. You will benefit from the exposure to the wide case-mix at KKH. KKH is a major paediatric university teaching hospital accredited by JCI as an Academic Medical Centre (AMC), and the only hospital nationally affiliated with all three Singapore medical schools – NUS Yong Loo Lin School of Medicine, Duke-NUS Medical School and Lee Kong Chian School of Medicine. Paediatrics Residents also rotate through the neonatology department at Singapore General Hospital (SGH) and child psychiatry at Institute of Mental Health as well as the School Health Service for ambulatory rotations.
