INTRODUCTION

The "Essentials in Trauma and Emergency General Surgery" (ETEGS) course aims to provide participants with a platform to review and perform common techniques and surgical maneuvers encountered in the setting of common emergency GS and trauma scenarios. Coupled with the application of a well-established animal model (live porcine) and access to real-life practical operating theatre (OT) setup and equipment, this course will allow participants to perform the various surgical procedures in a realistic and supervised environment.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

- 1. Familiarisation with typical OT equipment used for the performance of common General Surgery procedures
- 2. Reinforce common surgical techniques and approaches need in emergency General Surgery
- 3. Reinforce surgical techniques for managing common emergency GS conditions
- 4. Introduction to advanced surgical techniques for exposures and maneuvers in Trauma

PROGRAMME OVERVIEW

Practical hands-on session using porcine specimens.

- 1. Safe laparoscopic entry and techniques for laparoscopic bowel resection, cholecystectomy, and perforated ulcer repair
- 2. Open access to the abdomen (laparotomy) for bowel resection, splenectomy and for trauma
- 3. Access to the retroperitoneum and thorax (thoracotomy) for trauma to the great vessels and cardio-pulmonary injury
