Basic Temporal Bone and Advanced Hearing Implant Course

Saturday to Tuesday | 7-10 September 2024

INTRODUCTION

This is a progressive 4 day workshop helmed by expert local and international faculty and held in a state-of-the-art facility. It will benefit otorhinolaryngologists of varying experience, from surgeons-in-training to trained subspecialists aiming to develop expertise in advanced hearing implant work. This workshop is split into 2 modules, and participants have the option to both or pick the module best suited to their objectives:

7-8 September: Basic Temporal Bone Course

Aimed to familiarise participants of all levels of expertise with important surgical landmarks in the temporal bone. An emphasis will be placed on **hands-on temporal bone dissection** and participants will be guided through key otological procedures including middle ear dissection, mastoidectomy, posterior tympanotomy, CI electrode insertion, labyrinthectomy, IAC access, and more.

9-10 September: Advanced Hearing Implant Course

Aimed at intermediate to expert participants, this course immerses participants into the intricacies of performing various hearing implants, including cochlear implants and the different bone conduction implants. Concise lectures will equip participants with knowledge including operative setup, radiological review/ complex anatomy, finer points in implant candidate selection, hearing preservation techniques, simultaneous schwannoma removal and CI insertion, post operative rehabilitation, and more. An emphasis will be placed on **hands-on cadaveric head dissection**.

Dissection course features

- 1 participant per drilling station
- Microscope video output in all stations
- Close supervision by expert local and international faculty

INTRODUCTION

Concurrent to the Advanced Hearing Implant course (SingHealth ENT Fortnight), we are offering a 2-day aural (re)habilitation workshop focused on the allied health team's role in the cochlear implantation journey. Recognising that post-surgery support for cochlear implant patients is critical for good outcomes, this course will introduce surgeons, audiologists and therapists/educators to a holistic approach in cochlear implant management. Since 2001, the team at Centre for Hearing & Ear Implants has been providing transdisciplinary care to patients and their families. Cross disciplinary learning from this course will give participants a fresh insight and perspective.

- Learn about cochlear implant candidacy selection and assessments
- Learn about MAPping protocols and outcome measures
- Learn about therapy goals and strategies used
- Learn about potential issues and ways to mitigate them
