

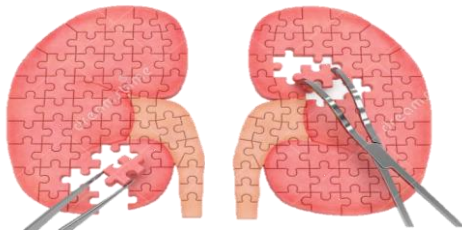


4th Laparoscopic Partial Nephrectomy Workshop
