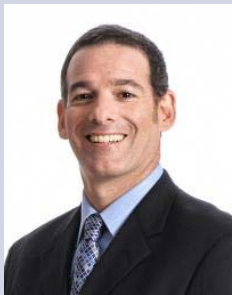

An Overview

This course will present an introduction to a 'Five-Step' approach to making a successful business case to promote a health innovation, be it a drug, device, or health promotion initiative. This includes an introduction to key concepts in health technology assessment (HTA) and economic evaluation and how they are being used to evaluate drugs and devices, including by Singapore's new Agency for Care Effectiveness (ACE). The course is a mix of lecture, discussion, case studies, and exercises.

The course benefits from Dr. Finkelstein's over 20 years of industry and academic experience in health technology assessment and economic evaluation. He has published over 180 manuscripts and 2 books and his publications have been cited over 21,000 times. He was listed as one of the World's Most Highly Cited Researchers in 2015 and 2016 by Thomson Reuters and Clarivate Analytics, respectively.
